

Does AES Indiana offer net metering?

AES Indiana offers net metering to eligible customers who have installed eligible net metering energy resources up to 1 MW in size, or other emerging renewable energy technologies the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission determines appropriate with an approved interconnection agreement. What types of generators are eligible for Rate EDG?

What does the AES Ohio net meter measure?

The AES Ohio net meter measures not only how much energy we deliver to your home, but also how much energy you put back on the grid. Will my bill detail how much energy I produce? AES Ohio measures how much energy is delivered to customers and how much energy is received from customers through the meter.

Does AES Ohio offer net metering?

All AES Ohio customers can take advantage of net metering. To be eligible, customers must meet all of the following requirements: Use a renewable resource (solar, wind, biomass, landfill gas, or hydropower) or use a microturbine (combustion turbine) or a fuel cell. Have the equipment located on your property.

What is net metering?

What is different on a net metering bill? If you install solar panels or other distributed generation at your home or business, the Usage Detail section of your AES Ohio bill will change.

Net metering billing and payment rules are defined in AES Ohio's tariff approved by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio. See section D (Net Metering).

Ohio's major utilities, like AEP Ohio, Duke Energy, and AES, generally offer net metering, and Cooperatives such as South Central Power do not. Still, you'll need to confirm your utility's ...

Net metering is the difference between how much energy AES Ohio delivers to you and how much energy we receive from you. The difference is measured by a net meter installed by AES Ohio after ...
