Energy Minister Denys Shmyhal reported "a cascade shutdown" in Ukraine's power grid in the morning on Jan. 31.

"The situation in Kyiv remains one of the most difficult - currently, up to 50% of consumers in the capital are without electricity," Ukraine's energy ministry said on Telegram.

They noted that in Kiev, residents already live without electricity for up to 16 hours a day, and enterprises mostly work on generators. Kiev is counting on an energy truce. At the same time, ...
